

Vocabulary Lists:

A vocabulary list is due each week at the beginning of class. The list should have your heading at the top right corner of the page. (Name, date, Class day):Ex. WV Year 1

The list should have at least 10 words from your reading from the week. Each word should be numbered and the reading source given for that word.

Example:

1. Crown: a royal or imperial headdress or cap of sovereignty (Plato's Republic)

You may not define a word using the root word. For example:

Tyrannical: characteristic of a tyrant.

The root word must be defined. Definitions should be thorough and should define the word in the context that it is used in your reading.

Words should be double spaced.

You may use a vocabulary word once for the entire year; this includes different variations of the same word: i.e. tyrant, tyrannical, tyranny. A program like Microsoft Excel will help you keep track of your words used throughout the year.

Each list is worth 100 points; 10 points for each word.

If a list is not turned in on time, 10 points will be deducted from the grade for each week it is late. I will only allow two weeks for these lists to be late. After that, it will be a zero.
